Its purchase by the banker Sir Francis Child, founder of Child & Co, now owned by the National Trust

Sir Francis's grandsons employed Scottish architect Robert Adam, the most fashionable architects in Britain, in front of The Admiralty, Whitehall (1760) ; and the interior of Syon House interior, Brentford (1762-1769).

The Child family made their money by owning part of the East India Company. It was Nationalised but many Indian treasures lie within the House.
